



Objective of COEL





Apprenticeship Program

Apprenticeship Duration (Machine Operator):

 Duration of the program is 01 year of which 03 months in COEL Payroll and 09 months in industry payroll.

Apprentice Placement:

 COEL finds out the demand of skilled workers from different factories and commence enrolling trainees upon signing agreement or MoU.

Performance Monitoring Mechanism:

- An in-charge/mentor for each batch from the respective industry supervises every trainee.
- Log-book of each trainee are routinely checked by the supervisor.











Soft skill training for mid –Level Management
